SUMMARY

The **Sydney Disability Connection Expo 2022** was held at the International Convention Centre Sydney on Friday, July 1st and Saturday, July 2nd, 2022.

The Expo provided an environment in which participants, parents, carers and NDIS service providers could connect and engage. More than 250 providers as well as a tailored concierge service were on hand to help attendees navigate the complexities of the NDIS. With a combined PR and social media reach of over 6.07million impressions, over the two days 7,058 visitors registered for the Expo. Through our Expo Gala Dinner, we also managed to raise \$7,500 for RizeUp and The Tourette Syndrome Association of Australia.


Comprehensive marketing campaigns are the bedrock of the success of our national expos, building a groundswell of interest in the event and in participating exhibitors.





NATIONAL DISABILITY LEADERSHIP ORGANISATION

MEMBERSHIP

The National Disability Leadership Organisation (NDLO) has been created to support the NDIS with their initiative to empower participants, by acting as a vehicle to accelerate the rate of positive change in the sector.

We'll achieve this by:

- Providing services to people with a physical, neurological or psychosocial disability who require direct support services to find and access service options to support the full utilisation of funding available to them through the National Disability Insurance Scheme
- Arranging opportunities and events for people with disabilities to interact with other people and have the same life experiences as people who do not have a physical or mental disability through easing the challenges of service access
- Educating the public on the importance of the value in the inclusion and recognition of all people in Australian to have choice and control in their lives
- Advocating for people with disabilities by promoting changes in the law and policy on how Australians living with disabilities receive services, funding and support; and
- Providing support to community benefit organisations by raising funds through various events and initiatives and providing a range of in kind and financial assistance opportunities to not for profit projects through Australia

Through its work, the NDLO will work with NDIS to bring about needed changes in the sector to ensure frustrations and bottlenecks are relieved one at a time.
